


Allergies: Modify Reactions for Nurses

Delete an Allergy Reaction Prior to Completing the Allergy Entry

When an incorrect allergy reaction is entered, it may be deleted prior to completing the entry.

1. Right click on the incorrect reaction.
2. Select delete. Do not select Cancel.
3. Complete the entry with the correct reaction.




Canceling a Previously Documented Incorrect Allergy Reaction


A previously documented allergy reaction can be corrected using the **Modify** option.

1. Go to Allergies in the patient's chart from one of three locations.


- a. The Allergies hyperlink within the Adult or Pediatric Intake - Nursing Workflow.



- b. The Allergies tab on the dark blue menu.




- c. The Allergies hyperlink on the demographic bar.



2. Select **Modify** using one of these methods.


- a. Highlight the allergy and click the **Modify** button
- b. Right click on the allergy and select **Modify**.






