


Blood Transfusion Process (MMC ED) for Emergency Department Clinical Staff


ED Transfusion Process

• Provider orders blood product. Note: GTABS will automatically order if no GTABS result is in the EHR from the last 72 hours.



- Unit Clerk starts the Blood Products Pick Up/Send Slip. RN signs the slip and the unit clerk sends the slip to the Blood Bank.
- Blood Bank sends the units to the ED when available.
- Staff person removing the blood product from the tube system signs the Blood Products Pick Up/Send Slip and returns the slip to the Blood Bank.
- RN verifies the blood product and the patient using two patient identifiers and a second licensed staff person.
- The RN starts the paper Blood Transfusion Record and administers the blood.
- RN documents See paper record on the Patient Update form.
- Once the transfusion and paper documentation are completed, RN documents the completion of the blood product on the Patient Update form.
