

What is the External Rx History?

The External Rx History is a tool that can assist with obtaining a home medication list. This tool provides access to SureScripts which is a database that lists prescriptions filled by patients.

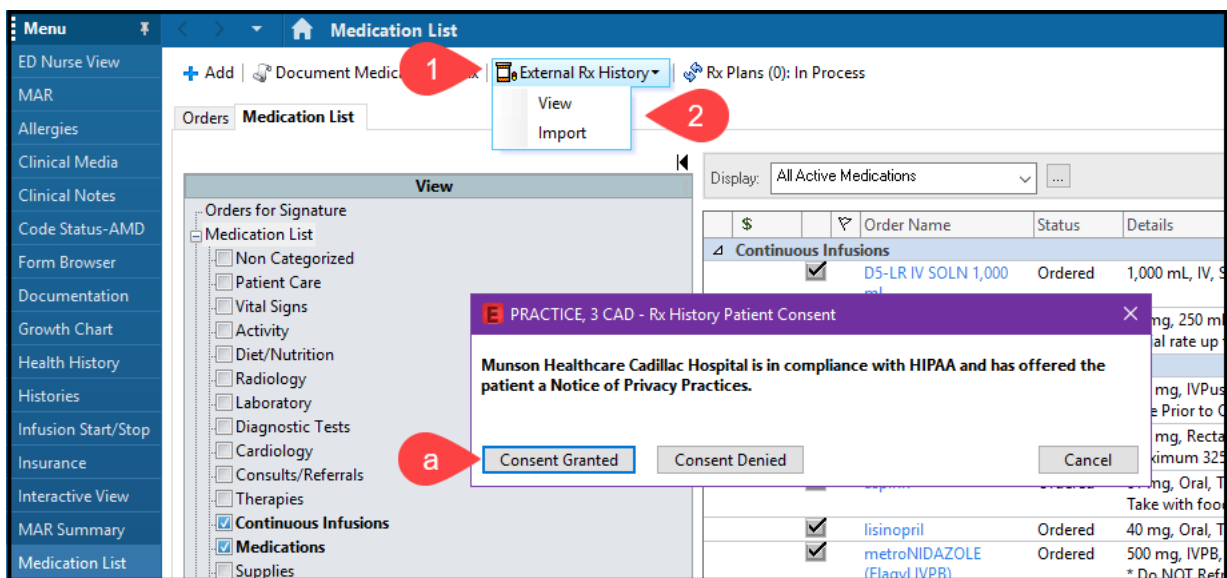
NOTE: The External Rx History may be incomplete, and users should not rely solely on this data to make any clinical decisions. A second source is still necessary with the use of External Rx History.

External Rx History

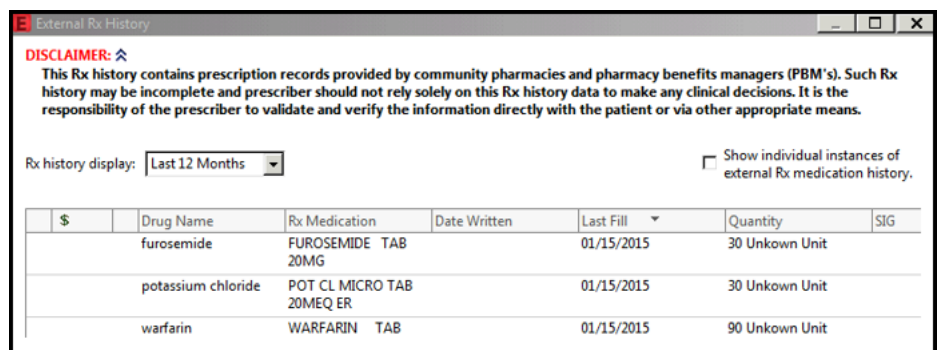
To use External Rx History:

1. Click External Rx History.
 - a. Click Consent Granted.
2. From the drop down select **View** or **Import**.

When selecting External Rx History for the first time for a patient, you will be prompted to have your patient verify/grant consent. While this is obtained on the face sheet during the registration process, it needs to be acknowledged electronically.



- a. **View** displays a window with a list of the external prescriptions filled. Users can view the prescriptions, but no additional actions are available using this selection.



- b. **Import** is the recommended selection because displays side by side windows with **External History** on left and the **Document Medications by Hx** on the right. Users can safely add and manage medications from this view to the Home Medication List without having to transition back and forth between two windows (see below).

Recommended Display:
Last 12 Months, to avoid missing prescriptions

Removing the check mark will group multiple prescription fills of the same medication for the set time frame

Right click option is available to modify medications as currently done in Document Medication by Hx

Indicates a medication is not on the current Home Medication List

Click to add the medication to the Home Medication List
