

Focus Note Use

The Focus Note PowerForm is used for documenting the following:

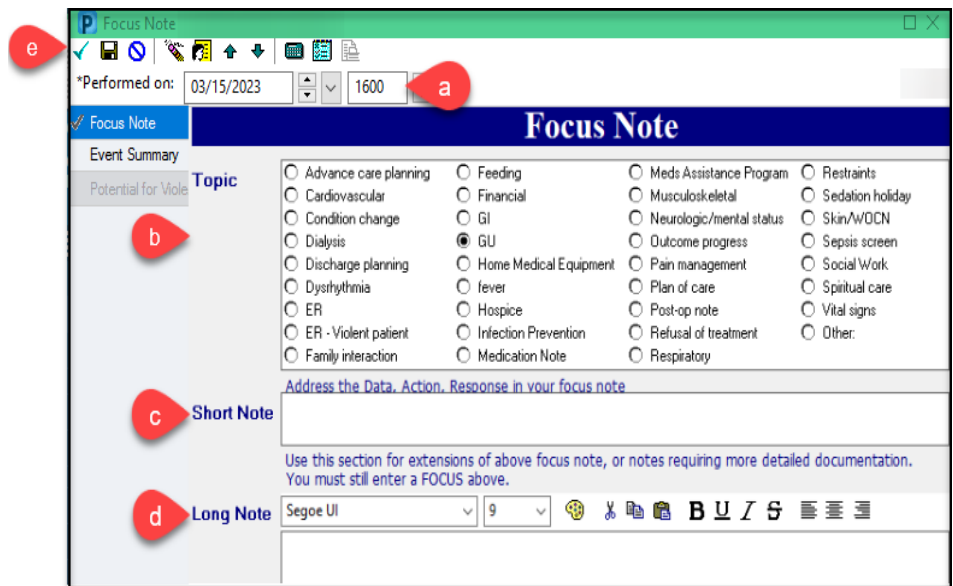
1. Unusual or unexpected events:
 - a) Condition changes in:
 - Mentation (example, sudden confusion or slurred speech).
 - Withdrawal from nicotine, alcohol, or other substances.
 - Mobility/gait.
 - b) In the event of MRT/Code Blue.
2. Nursing or medical interventions:
 - a) Oxygen level changes with treatment/patient response.
 - b) Blood pressure and heart rate level changes with treatment/patient response.
 - c) Cardiac rhythm changes and response to treatment/patient response.
3. Emotional or psychological needs of the patient and family.
4. Abnormal patient finding that needs in-depth explanation.

Note: MRT/Code Blue documentation occurs on paper. A nurse views the paper chart for all details.

Focus Note Documentation

The Focus Note is accessed from AdHoc. To document:

- a) Verify correct date and time in Performed on.
- b) Choose the Topic of an event.
- c) Document the information in Short Note using the Data/Action/Response (DAR) format if the note has less than 255 characters.
- d) Document the information in Long Note using the DAR format if the note has 255 characters or more.
- e) Sign.



Note: Do not use exact times when documenting a focus note unless the times exactly match what is documented in the chart.

Example:

D: Patient's urine output 100ml for last 8 hours.
 A: Dr. Test notified. Order for 1000ml normal saline bolus received.
 R: RN to wait for patient's response which will be documented in the 2nd focus note.

Document the 2nd Focus note later if patient's response is not seen immediately.

Example:

R: Patient's urine output 400ml for last 4 hours.
