

# Interactive View: Documentation of Labor, Birth, and Delivery for the Primary RN

for Maternity Nurses

During delivery the Primary RN documents results for the laboring mother while the Secondary RN documents results for the fetus or baby. See the Interactive View: Documenting Birth for Secondary RN document located on the Hospital Maternity Nursing Documentation webpage.

## Delivery Documentation

The primary RN will document the patient's labor in the OB Pregnancy band in the OB Delivery until the time of delivery.

1. Select the **Labor/Delivery Information** section of the OB Delivery band of IView in the mother's chart.
2. Document the details of the delivery.

**In the event of a Cesarean delivery, document the complication indicating C-section.**

**Maternal Delivery Complications, Baby**

- none
- Excessive bleeding
- Failed induction
- Pregnancy induced hypertension
- Shoulder dystocia

## Recovery Documentation

The OB Recovery band is used to document care for the 2 hours following **both cesarean and vaginal** deliveries.

1. Select the **OB Recovery** band.
2. Document the details of recovery.

**If the Lochia amount is Heavy, additional fields will appear.**

Refer to the Postpartum Hemorrhage document for additional details.

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- In the event of a cesarean delivery, create a dynamic group to document the patient's wound.

2. Click the **Flowsheet** dropdown arrow.
3. Select **Delivery Record**.
4. Select viewing preference.

The Delivery Record provides a summary of all documentation related to the labor, delivery, and immediate newborn assessment and care.
