

Interdisciplinary Plans of Care (IPOC): Documenting for Maternity Nurses

Cerner PowerChart

Expectation

- The nurse will document in each IPOC:
 - Once per shift
 - At discharge
 - o At transfer
- If the patient is transferred to a different level of care within the hospital, the nurse will discontinue each IPOC.

Navigation

1. From the Orders section within the patient's chart, click on Document in a Plan tab.



- 2. The Description column will show each IPOCs details and includes:
 - Outcome lcon (0) = indicates the measurable outcome/goal to be met and documented by discharge.
 - Intervention Icon = activities of care performed by staff to assist the patient in achieving their outcome/goal.
 - c. Indicator Icon i = the patient's progress toward the outcome/goal. This will pull information from different areas of the patient's chart, such as Interactive View.



- i. Click any of the + sign to see results.
- 3. The Last Evaluated column shows the most recent date and time results were charted and whether results meet the target range of the outcome/goal.
 - a. 🖌 indicates the outcome/goal was met.
 - b. X indicates the outcome/goal was not met.



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- 4. Target column describes when each outcome should be met.
 - a. All outcomes have a target of 'By Discharge'. All outcomes should be met on or prior to discharge.
- 5. Status column will have a green check mark button.
 - a. This button is used to document on the outcomes and interventions.

Documenting

- 1. Review the outcome/goal.
- 2. Open indicators by clicking on the + sign to view the patient's progress toward the outcome/goal.
- 3. Review the intervention(s).
 - a. If you performed the intervention, click on click the green check mark and the intervention description window will appear.

- b. The intervention description window will automatically populate as done with today's date and time.

- 4. When an outcome is met, on or before discharge, the green check button can be selected as shown above.
- 5. When all interventions and or outcomes are documented click on Sign Documentation
- 6. At discharge, staff must chart on each goal and intervention. Any unmet goals must be addressed with the plan for the patient documented.







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
