

Maternity Tracking Board: Icons & Basics

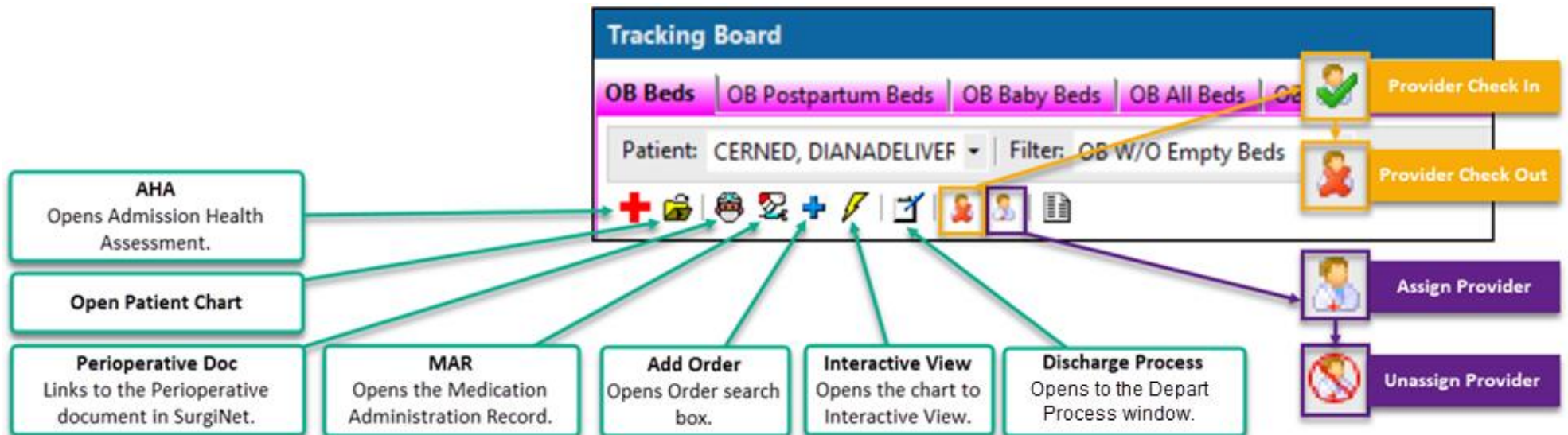

Description

The Maternity Tracking Board is:

- An organizer that all RNs, UCs, UAs, and NAs utilize.
- A snapshot of information that is pulled in from the documentation in the patient’s chart. For example: EGA, Gravida, Para, Dilation, Effacement, Station, ROM, Fluid Description, PPH, Communication columns.
- Only used by OB & C3.
- Expected to be checked for new information at least every two hours.

Icons

Columns

- Open Chart** – double click on the blue triangle to open the chart.
- Bed** – displays room number and bed.
- VIP** – if a star appears this means that the patient has opted out of our directory and they do not want to be found. Hover over the star to see the patient's name.
- Name** – displays the patient Last, First name.
- Status** – click the drop down to change the status of the patient as they progress through labor and delivery.
- A** – allergy icon will display here. Hover to see the patient's allergies and double click the icon to see additional details.
- OB Nurse** – the first and last initial of the nurse assigned to the patient and the five-digit phone number will display.
- Attending** – displays the attending provider.
- EGA** – estimated gestation age will display. If the patient has delivered you will see the green circle, hover to see EGA at birth.
- G** – gravida.
- P** – para.
- Dil** – dilation.
- Eff** – effacement.
- Sta** – station.
- ROM** – rupture of membrane status.
- Fluid Descr** – fluid description.
- PPH** – displays postpartum hemorrhage risk. Hover over icon to view.
- Communication** – displays icons that provide information and risk factors. Hover over the icons to view.
- Rubella** – displays rubella status. NI = nonimmune and I = Immune.
- GBS** – displays group beta strep status. P = positive, N = Negative, and U = Unknown.
- IV Stop Times** – for observation/triage patients. See IV Start and Stop Times education document located on the Hospital Maternity Nursing Tracking Board webpage.
- Activities/Tasks** – charting tasks and reminders. See Task Documentation education located on the Hospital Maternity Nursing Tracking Board webpage.
- Pt Checks** – displays the date and time of the last head to toe assessment.
- NR** – nurse review icon will display if there are new orders that require a nurse review.
- Lab** – if new labs are ordered you will see the number ordered vs the number resulted. Right click on the box to see the ordered labs, double click to bring up a result flowsheet.
