

NURSING PROCESS FOR SUNQUEST DOWNTIME

Nursing units, please be sure you have entered routine lab orders for tomorrow before the downtime begins.

Blood Collection – New Orders During Downtime

STAT, NOW & today Timed/Dated draws:

- a. Page the phlebotomist (or IV Therapist if patient is an IV Draw).
- b. Prepare a Downtime Form (necessary to ID patient).
- c. Write the patient location & bed on the form.
- d. **DO NOT** enter orders in PowerChart (lab will enter when downtime is complete).

Routine orders during a downtime:

- a. Prepare a downtime form and hold at nursing station for phlebotomist.
- b. **Hold** form(s) at nursing station for phlebotomist to pick up.

<u>Future Timed/Dated Draw</u>:

a. Wait to enter order(s) in PowerChart until downtime is complete.

Recurring Orders:

a. If collection starts during downtime, prepare a downtime form for each draw needed during downtime.

Ensure the <u>PATIENT LOCATION</u> and <u>PHONE NUMBER</u> where the results are to be sent/called is LEGIBLE on the downtime form. Results will be delayed if information is illegible or absent.

Nurse Collected Specimens (i.e., urine, sputum, etc.):

- a. Prepare a Downtime Form (necessary to ID patient).
- b. **DO NOT** enter orders in PowerChart (lab will enter when downtime is complete).

Results:

- > STAT, ASAP, critical results, and heparin-protocol PTTs:
 - Will be sent to the unit or other specified location (e.g., PACU, OP surgery, Cath lab, etc.) via pneumatic tube.
 - OR patient results will be phoned to the specific unit or room indicated on requisition.
- > Critical care units ED, ICU, NICU, A2, A3, and B2 will receive results on paper via pneumatic tube.
- > Lab staff will be unable to look up results of testing performed prior to the downtime. Please refer to patient's chart for these results.
- Once Sunquest returns live, orders and tests collected and performed during downtime are entered by lab staff. <u>Results will be available in PowerChart</u> upon verification.
