

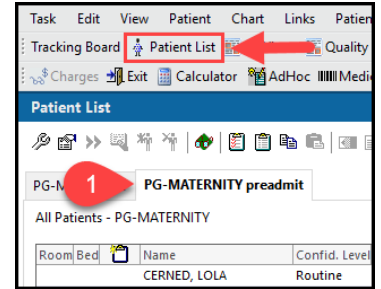
Outpatient Injections & Non-Stress Test Process for Maternity Nurses

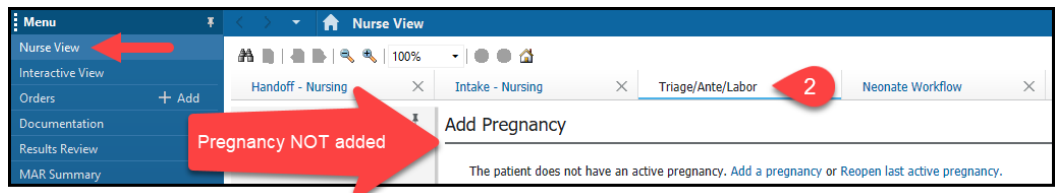
Process

An outpatient arrives for either a Rhogam or Betamethasone injection or Non-Stress Test:

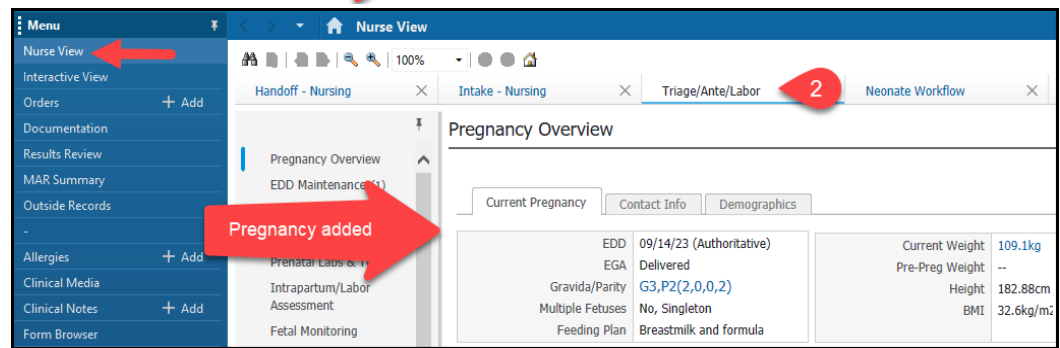
1. Locate the patient on the preadmit patient list and open their chart.
NOTE: Outpatients do not show up on the Tracking Board.



2. From Nurse View on the dark menu, select the Triage/Ante/Labor Workflow tab and determine if a pregnancy has been added. If no pregnancy has been added, add the pregnancy.

3. Enter appropriate order for Rhogam, Betamethasone, or a Non-Stress Test in the Orders tab of the patient's chart.
4. For injections, administer the injection following the medication administration process.

5. For a Non-Stress Test, hook the patient up to the FetaLink monitor.

6. From Interactive View on the dark menu, go to the OB Pregnancy Band.
 - a. Under OB Visit Assessment View, document the Reason for Visit and the associated information.
