

Clinical Reconciliation of Problems, Allergies, Home Medications, and Immunizations, also known as PAMI, is the process of verifying clinical data that exists within the EMR is consistent with external sources.

How to Reconcile PAMI

- **Outside records (external sources)** such as CCDs (Continuity of Care documents) will automatically come into the chart. **Purple diamond** icons indicate outside records/sources are present.
 - To reconcile PAMI go to Nurse View. Select either Adult or Pediatric Intake Nursing Workflow and follow steps listed below:

Histories – Problem Tab

- Outside records (purple diamonds) are present:
 - Select the problem.

Anxiety (finding) 🔶	Add Discard

- o Ask patient/family about the problem, then click
 - Add will add the problem to the local record.
 - Discard will remove the problem from the list.
 - Note: Leave any problems (purple diamonds) you are not certain of because the provider is ultimately responsible for management of the problem list.

No Chronic Problems



- Never use Finish Later.
- No outside records (no purple diamonds) are present still requires reconciliation:
 - O Click Complete Reconciliation

Allergies

- Outside records (purple diamonds) are present:
 - \circ Select the allergy.
 - \circ $\;$ Ask the patient/family about the allergy, then click:
 - Add will add the allergy.

PAMI Reconciliation

- Cerner PowerChart JOB AID
- Discard will remove the allergy if not accurate or is an exact duplicate of an allergy in the local record.
- **Unsure**: leave allergy as a purple diamond.
- Click **Complete Reconciliation**.
- No outside records (purple diamonds) are present:
 - Review local record allergies.
 - Click Complete Reconciliation.

No Known Allergies

- Patient has no allergies. Select
 - Click Complete Reconciliation.
 - Patient has new allergies not listed so user needs to follow allergy entry process:
 - Always select a coded allergy option instead of a 'free text' option.

Home Medications

- Purple diamonds will **Not** display in this section.
- Home medications that have been previously documented will display.
- Click Complete History
 - Entering new, changed and/or completed medications need to be entered following the medication by history process.
- If the Reconciliation Status bar displays a green checkmark, reconciliation has been completed and no

further action needed. Status: Meds History Admission Transfer Discharge

Immunizations

- Outside records (purple diamonds) present:
 - Select the vaccine.
 - Ask patient/family if patient has received the vaccine, then click:
 - Add will enter the vaccine to the local record.
 - **Discard** will remove the vaccine from the list.
 - **Unsure:** leave purple diamond.
 - \circ $\;$ No further action is needed.
 - No outside records no further action is needed.
