

Glucose Management Indicator (GMI) Documentation

Opening the Transcribed Glucose Management Indicator (GMI) PowerForm:

- 1. Navigate to **AdHoc** on the PowerChart toolbar.
- Locate and select the Transcribed Glucose
 Management Indicator (GMI) PowerForm
 from the Commonly Used folder.
- 3. Click Chart.



Transcribed Glucose Management Indicator (GMI) PowerForm documentation:

- Update the Performed on date to match the End Date for the GMI.
- 5. Enter the **Start Date** and **End Date**.
 - Note: Both dates must be entered.
- 6. Document the GMI results.
- Click the green check mark to sign and save the documentation.
