
Summary: A new quality workflow has been created to document alcohol screening to meet quality measures for reimbursement. The U.S. Preventive Services Task Force recommends that clinicians screen adults aged 18 and older for alcohol misuse and provide persons engaged in risky or hazardous drinking with brief behavioral counseling interventions to reduce alcohol misuse.

Workflow

- 1. In the Ambulatory Workflow, navigate to the Scales and Assessment Component to view the Alcohol/AUDIT-C Score once completed by clinical staff.
- 2. If the score is Positive: Document Annual Screening for alcohol and follow up plan.
 - a. Add the ICD-10 code: Z13.39 Alcohol screening to patient's Problem List.
