## **Patient Status Color Legend**

The color of the status bar in the Ambulatory Organizer indicates the patient's status of the appointment. The color will update as a patient progresses through their clinic visit. The patient's status will change automatically based on actions completed within PowerChart or Revenue Cycle, but may also be adjusted manually.
