

Summary: A new optional Controlled Substance Alert is available for ambulatory providers to create and alert providers and prescribers of a patient’s history with controlled substance abuse or misuse. This alert is documented in the Opioid Review component. Once documented, a Controlled Substance Alert will display once per day upon opening the patient's chart, for providers and prescribers only.

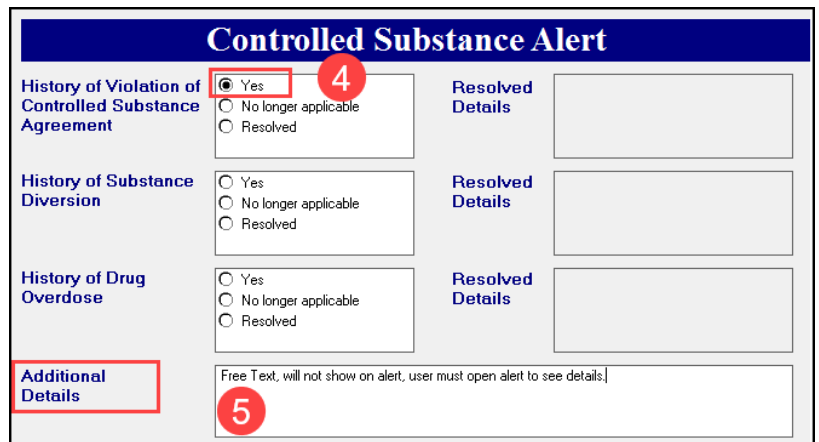
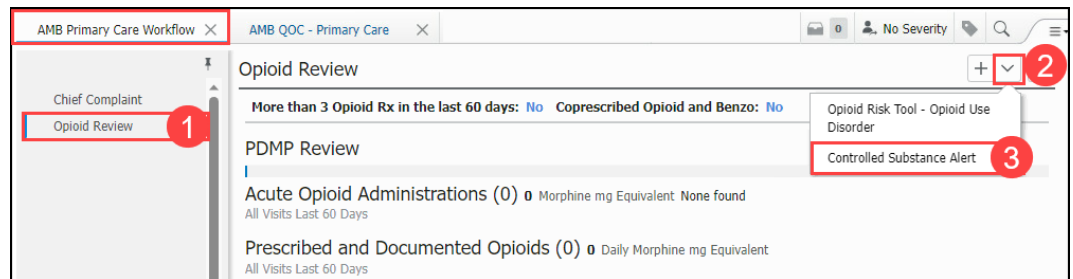

Controlled Substance Alert Creation and / or Resolution

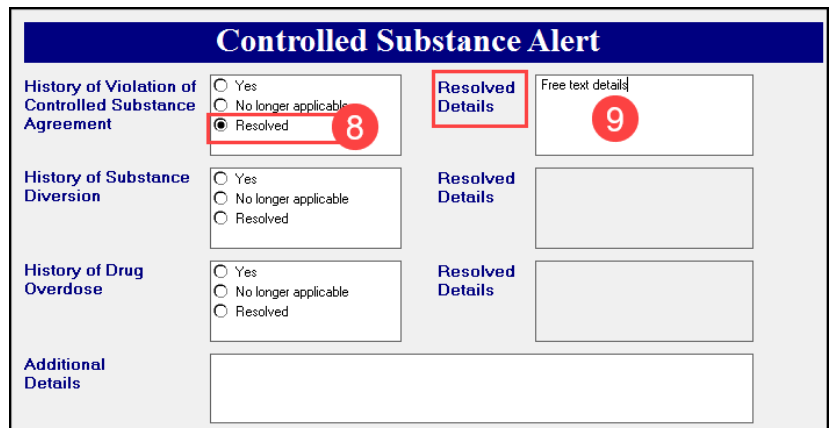
To create a Controlled Substance Alert:

1. Navigate to the Opioid Review component within the AMB Specialty Workflow.
2. Click the drop-down within the component.
3. Select the Controlled Substance Alert.
4. Select Yes, where applicable.
5. Add Additional Details by free texting.
Note: Additional Details will not show on alert firing, the alert must be opened to read the details.
6. Click the green check mark to sign the PowerForm .



To resolve a Controlled Substance Alert:

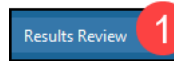
7. If a Controlled Substance issue has been resolved or is no longer applicable, follow the above steps 1-3 to open the alert documentation.
8. Select Resolved or No longer applicable.
9. The Resolved Details box becomes available to free text any details if Resolved is selected.
10. Click the green check mark to sign the PowerForm .



Note: Once a Controlled Substance Alert has been documented as Resolved or No longer applicable, the Controlled Substance Alert will no longer display when opening the patient's chart.

Controlled Substance Alert Documentation Review

1. Navigate to the Menu and select Results Review.
2. Select the Patient Assessment tab.
3. View previously documented Controlled Substance Alerts and details.
