

## Navigation

Command Name/Say	Function
<b>New line</b>	Presses Enter key once to start a new line.
<b>New paragraph</b>	Presses Enter key twice to start a new paragraph.
<b>Go to end of paragraph</b>	Moves the cursor within the same text control, to the end of the paragraph.
<b>Go to end of sentence</b>	Moves the cursor within the same text control, to the end of the sentence.
<b>Next field</b>	Moves the cursor to next [ ] in the template.
<b>Previous field</b>	Moves the cursor to previous [ ] in the template.
<b>First field</b>	Moves the cursor to first [ ] in the template.
<b>Last field</b>	Moves the cursor to last [ ] in the template.
<b>Accept defaults</b>	Accepts the default values in all remaining fields and removes the delimiters, [ ].
<b>Field complete</b>	Accepts the default value in the current field and removes the delimiters, [ ].
<b>Open bracket</b>	Enters/Transcribes [ , to use when creating variable Auto-Texts.
<b>Close bracket</b>	Enters/Transcribes ] , to use when creating variable Auto-Texts.

## Controlling Dragon

Command Name/Say	Function
<b>Close Dragon</b>	Minimizes the application to task bar.
<b>Open Dragon</b>	Maximizes the application.
<b>Open Dictation Box</b>	Opens the Dictation Box.
<b>Close Dictation Box</b>	Closes the Dictation Box.
<b>Transfer text</b>	Transfers text from the Dictation Box to the target application.
<b>Discard text</b>	Deletes text in the Dictation Box.
<b>Recall text</b>	Re-writes text in the Dictation Box.
<b>What can I say</b>	Displays the list of commands, Auto-Texts, the online help, and the Manage Vocabulary page.
<b>Manage Vocabulary or Manage words</b>	Displays the Manage Vocabulary page.
<b>Manage Commands or Manage Step-by-step Commands</b>	Opens the Manage Step-by-step Commands dialog box.
<b>Create Command or Add Command</b>	Opens the Manage Step-by-steps Commands dialog box and creates a new command, either with no information or with prior selected text.
<b>Manage Auto-Texts</b>	Opens the Manage Auto-Texts dialog box.
<b>Make that an Auto-Text or Create Auto-Text or Add Auto-Text</b>	Opens the Manage Auto-Texts dialog box and creates a new Auto-text, either with no information or with prior selected text.
<b>Launch help</b>	Opens the Dragon Help.
<b>Quit help</b>	Closes the Dragon Help.

## Correction/Editing Text

Command Name/Say	Function
<b>Select all</b>	Selects all text recorded.
<b>Select this word</b>	Selects the word where the cursor is located.
<b>Select next word</b>	Selects word to the right of the cursor.
<b>Select previous word</b>	Selects word to the left of the cursor.
<b>Select first word</b>	Selects the first word of the recorded text.
<b>Select last word</b>	Selects the last word of the recorded text.
<b>Select [word]</b>	Selects the specified word.
<b>Select [word] to [word] or Select [word] through [word]</b>	Selects the specified text.
<b>Select first paragraph</b>	Selects the paragraph at the beginning of the dictation.
<b>Select last paragraph</b>	Selects the paragraph at the end of the dictation.
<b>Select first sentence</b>	Selects the sentence at the beginning of the dictation.
<b>Select last sentence</b>	Selects the sentence at the end of the dictation.
<b>Select previous paragraph</b>	Selects the previous paragraph.
<b>Select previous sentence</b>	Selects the previous sentence.
<b>Deselect that or Unselect that</b>	Cancel the selection.
<b>Scratch that or Delete that</b>	Deletes last bit of recorded text or selected text.
<b>Scratch word or Delete word</b>	Deletes the text next to the cursor.
<b>Resume with &lt;text&gt;</b>	Goes to a specific text position and deletes everything recorded after that point.
<b>Go back</b>	Returns the cursor to its position prior to selection.
<b>Undo that</b>	Executes Ctrl + Z in the application.
<b>Redo that</b>	Executes Ctrl + Y in the application.
<b>Insert before &lt;text&gt;</b>	Inserts the cursor before the specified text.
<b>Insert after &lt;text&gt;</b>	Inserts the cursor after the specified text.
<b>Cap that</b>	Capitalizes the first letter of each selected word, or all words of the last thing spoken.
<b>All caps that</b>	Capitalizes all letters of each selected word, or the last thing spoken.
<b>Bold that</b>	Makes the selected text bold.
<b>Italicize that</b>	Makes the selected text italic.
<b>Underline that</b>	Makes the selected text underlined.
<b>Normal that</b>	Makes the selected text normal.
