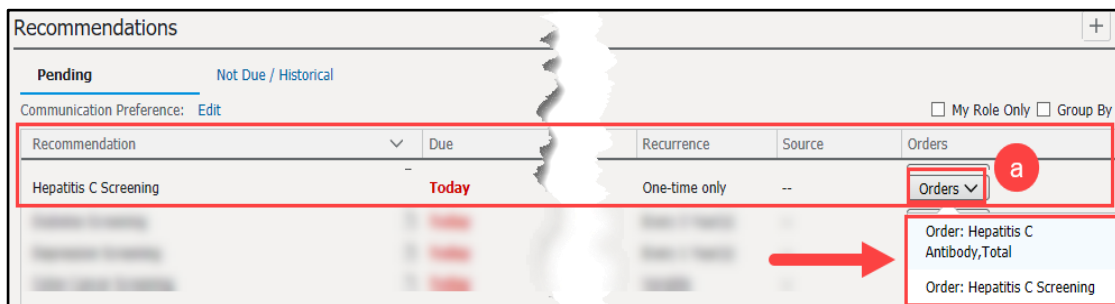
Summary: Hepatitis C Screening is recommended for all patients ages 18 through 79 years of age unless there is a documented Hepatitis C diagnosis (historical or present). This health maintenance recommendation will automatically display on the Recommendations component on the Ambulatory Workflow page one time.

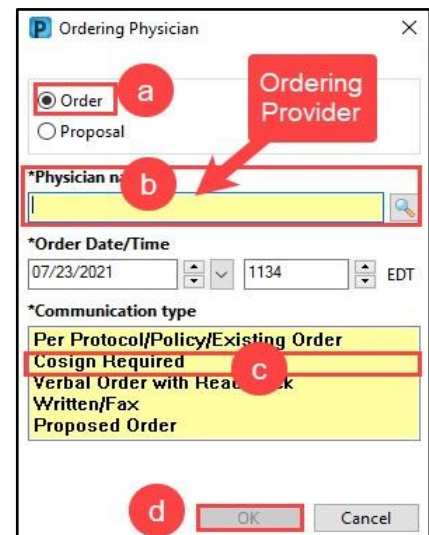
Hepatitis C Screening Due and Not Completed


If the patient is due for Hepatitis C Screening and the screening has **NOT** been completed:

1. From the **Recommendations** component:
 - a. Click **Orders** and select an order option:
 - Order: Hepatitis C Antibody, Total.
 - Order: Hepatitis C Screening.



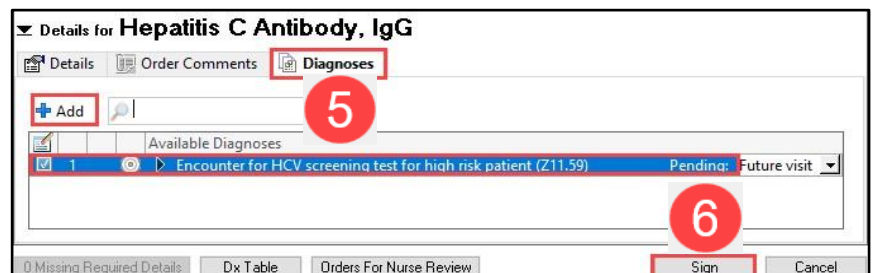
2. If clinical staff is placing the order, the Ordering Physician box appears:
 - a. Select **Order**.
 - b. Enter the ordering provider name.
 - c. Select the Communication type: **Cosign Required**.
 - d. Click **OK**.



3. Click **Orders for Signature**. 
4. Within Orders for Signature:
 - a. Click **Modify Details**.



5. Associate the appropriate diagnosis with the order.
6. Click **Sign**.



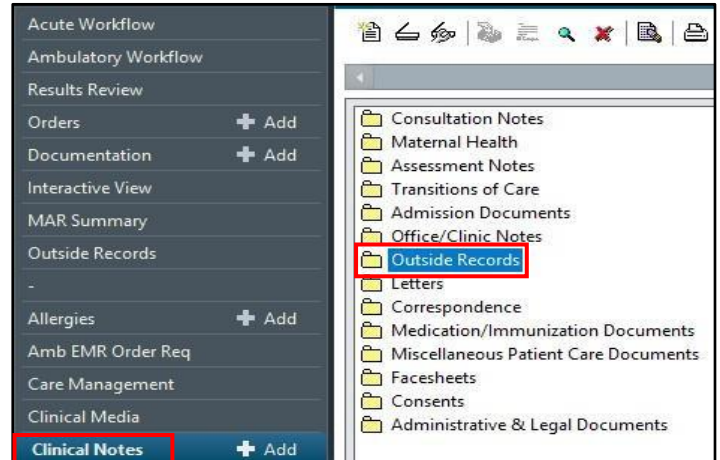
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Hepatitis C Screening Due and Completed Elsewhere

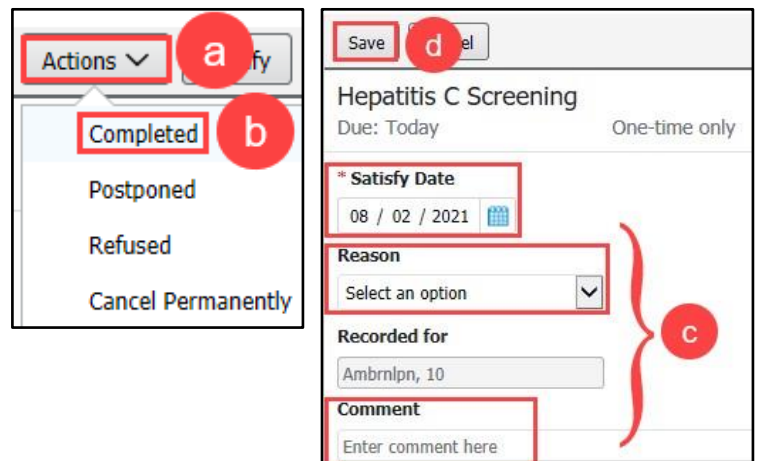
If the patient is due for Hepatitis C Screening and screening has been completed:

1. Within Clinical Notes, select **Outside Records** to review records for Hepatitis C lab results.



2. If results are available, document the Hepatitis C Screening as complete from the Recommendations component.

- a. Click **Actions**.
- b. Select **Completed**.
- c. Enter the completion details.
 - i. Enter the Satisfy Date as the date the test was performed.
 - ii. Select a Reason.
 - iii. Enter a Comment if necessary.
- d. Click **Save**.



Note: Providers are responsible for updating Recommendations yearly. If a Hepatitis result is available in Outside Records, care team members must manually satisfy the recommendation using the date the test was performed.
