

Home Medications Component for Providers

Cerner PowerChart Ambulatory EDUCATION

The Home Medications component on the AMB Workflow within Provider View contains a list of prescribed and documented home medications. At each clinic visit the Home Medications must be reviewed and reconciled. **Overview**

- 1. Clinical staff documents the patient's home medications during the clinical intake. A green check mark next to Meds History indicates this has been completed.
- 2. Medication details are displayed in columns.
- 3. A scroll icon indicates a documented home medication. A pill bottle icon indicates a Cerner-prescribed home medication.

Home Medication Reconciliation

Follow the steps for medication reconciliation:

- 4. Click the **Outpatient** hyperlink to complete the medication reconciliation (see the above image).
- 5. Select Continue, Create New RX, or Discontinue for all medications managed by the provider completing the reconciliation.
- 6. If a Cerner-prescribed home medication (indicated with a pill bottle) needs to be refilled, right-click on the medication, select Renew, and complete the supply and refill amount instead of using the middle column to create a new prescription.
