

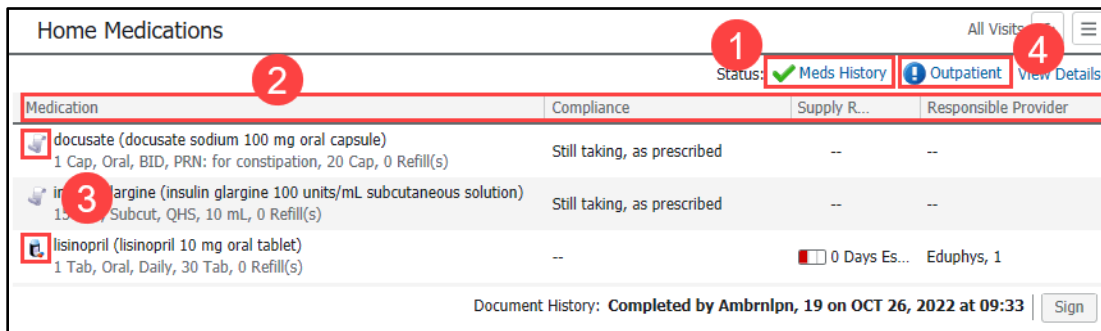
Home Medications Component for Providers

Cerner PowerChart Ambulatory EDUCATION

The Home Medications component on the AMB Workflow within Provider View contains a list of prescribed and documented home medications. At each clinic visit the Home Medications must be reviewed and reconciled.

Overview

1. Clinical staff documents the patient’s home medications during the clinical intake. A green check mark next to **Meds History** indicates this has been completed.
2. Medication details are displayed in columns.
3. A **scroll** icon indicates a documented home medication. A **pill bottle** icon indicates a Cerner-prescribed home medication.



Home Medication Reconciliation

Follow the steps for medication reconciliation:

4. Click the **Outpatient** hyperlink to complete the medication reconciliation (see the above image).
5. Select **Continue, Create New RX, or Discontinue** for all medications managed by the provider completing the reconciliation.
6. If a Cerner-prescribed home medication (indicated with a pill bottle) needs to be refilled, right-click on the medication, select **Renew**, and complete the supply and refill amount instead of using the middle column to create a new prescription.
7. Click **Acknowledge Remaining Home Meds** to document that the remaining medications managed by other providers have been reviewed.
8. Click **+Add** to add a new medication, if applicable.
9. The **x** icon indicates missing required details.
10. Click **Reconcile and Sign** when complete.
11. A green check will appear next to **Outpatient** once the home medication reconciliation is complete.
