

Overview

The Labs component in the AMB or Manage Specialty Workflow within the Provider View allows lab results to be viewed that have been collected within the system. The display configuration within the component can be adjusted by time range, display view, and filter selection.

1. Time range.
2. Display view.
3. Filters.

Labs Result Key

Lab results that are not within the normal value range will have an icon next to the lab value to indicate an abnormal lab value.

- indicates a below normal lab value.
- indicates an above normal lab value.
- indicates a critical value lab value.

Labs Result Details

1. Click on the lab name to display a trending graph for the lab values collected.
2. Click on the lab value to display more details including value ranges specific to that lab.

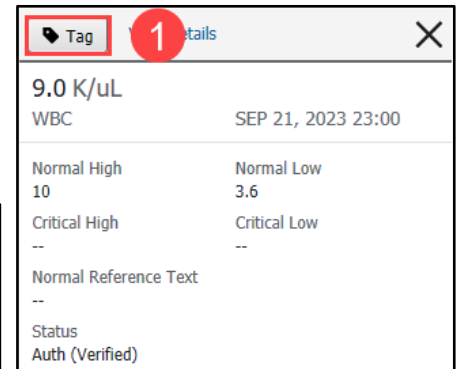
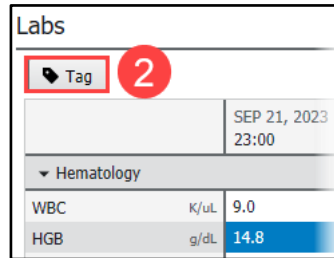
Tagging Lab Results

To Tag a lab result to display in a note:

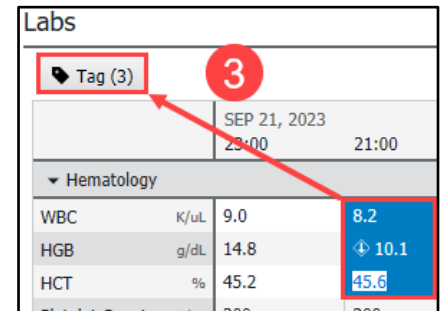
1. Click once on the desired lab value, and then click Tag in the action window.

OR

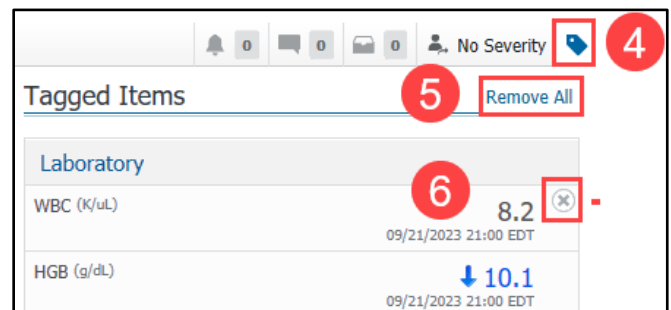
2. Click once on the desired lab value then click Tag at the top of the Labs component.



3. Multiple lab values can be tagged at once by holding down the Ctrl key and clicking on the desired lab values. Then click Tag at the top of the Labs component.



4. Click the Tagged Items icon to view tagged items.
5. Click Remove All to clear the Tagged Items list.
6. Click the X to remove an individual tagged item.



Note: The most recent set of labs results will automatically display into most note templates in the hospital setting. Other tagged lab results will also display once the note template is selected.
