

Post-Visit Problem List Documentation for Providers

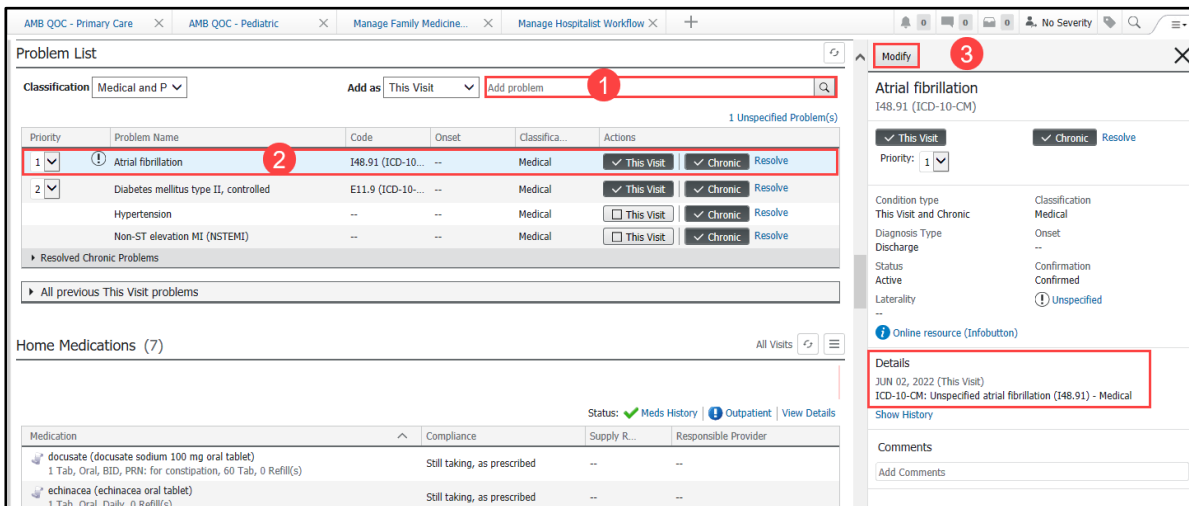
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Summary: Over 20 quality incentive program measures require documentation of ICD-10 diagnosis codes. To capture quality incentive dollars, the date associated with an ICD-10 diagnosis code (which can be found in the details on the problem list) must align to the encounter date of the patient's office visit. The recommended best practice is to add all **This Visit** diagnoses on the date of service.

ICD-10 Diagnosis Modification After the Visit

If a diagnosis is added after the date of service, the diagnosis date should be modified or back dated to match the date of service.

1. Search for and select the diagnosis to add.
2. Select the diagnosis on the Problem List.
3. Click modify.



4. Change the Date field to the date of service.
5. Click OK.
6. Repeat steps 2-5 for each diagnosis entered.
