

Quick Visit Component for Providers

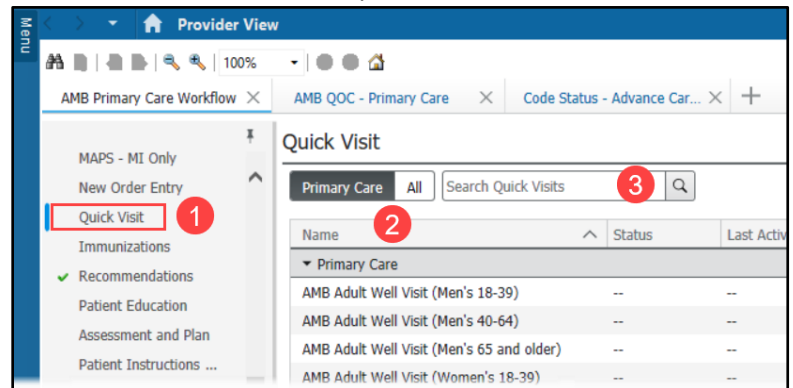

Overview

Quick visits are groupings of items that are commonly documented as part of routine visits. A provider can use these item groupings to quickly complete visits that are performed on a regular basis. Quick visits are best suited for routine visits that require minimal clinical decision support and contain little variance across patients and visits.

To access:

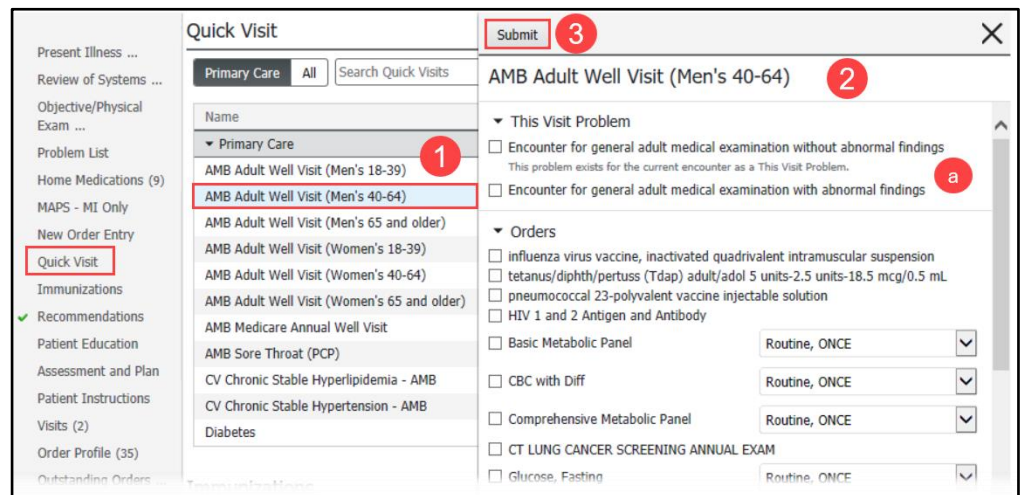
1. Navigate to the AMB Workflow in the Provider View and select the Quick Visit Component.
2. The system displays a list of available Quick Visits. Select the Primary Care or All buttons to filter.
3. The search box allows the provider to enter the name of the Quick Visit to open.



Completing a Quick Visit

To complete a Quick Visit:

1. Select a Quick Visit from the list.
2. In the quick visit dialog box, place a check in the appropriate check boxes under each section and complete the appropriate order sentence for each order, prescription, and charge required by the specific quick visit.
 - a. If a This Visit Problem is selected, it will be added to the patient's Problem List in the AMB workflow.
3. Click Submit.
4. Complete the Orders for Signature pop-up box, if an order, prescription, or charge was selected when completing the quick visit dialog box.



5. The system then displays the Quick Visit as submitted in the Workflow Quick Visits Component.
