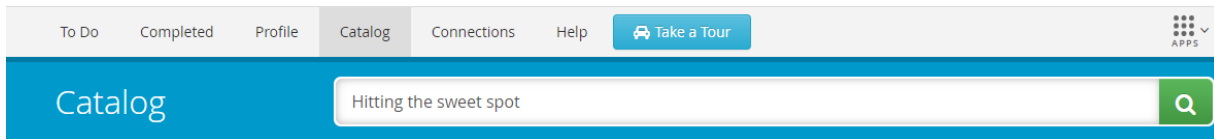

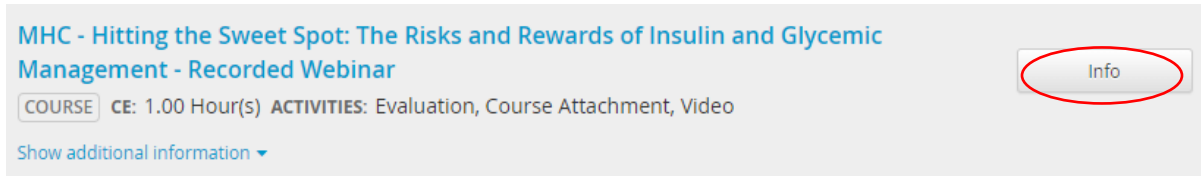


Steps for Registration in HealthStream

1. Sign in to your HealthStream account, go to **Catalog** and type, **“Hitting the Sweet Spot”** in the search bar.



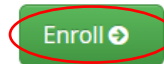

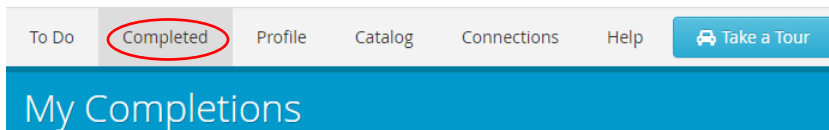
