Information System Alerts

Incident/Event	Code/Alert	Code/Alert Response Instructions
Information System Downtime or Issue	IS Alert	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Follow downtime procedures. See System Failure tab in the red Emergency Management Guidebook.

Facility Alerts

Incident/Event	Code	Code/Alert Response Instructions
Fire	Code Red	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remember: RACE – Rescue, Alarm, Contain, Extinguish/Evacuate.
Facility System Down	Facility Alert	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Follow downtime procedure. See System Failure tab in the red Emergency Management Guidebook.
Hazardous Spill or Exposure	Facility Alert	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hospital personnel who have been trained in hazardous materials response report to the identified area. All others stay clear.

Security Alerts

Incident/Event	Code/Alert	Code/Alert Response Instructions
Active Shooter, Weapon Situation, or Hostage Situation	Security Alert	<p>Hospital personnel in the area specified by the Security Alert Remember: RUN, HIDE (with a plan), FIGHT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Quickly assess the situation, develop a plan, and take action. Stay alert and don't panic. Evacuate if possible. Seek cover/protection and warn others of the situation. If possible, call 911. <p>All hospital personnel:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Upon hearing a Security Alert involving weapons, stay clear of announced location and instruct others to do the same. Close all patient and unit exit doors. Stand by for further instructions.
Violent Situation, No Weapon	Security Alert	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gray Team and staff able to assist responds to the area. All others stay clear.
Bomb Threat	Security Alert	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remain calm. Do not panic. Keep the caller on the line for as long as possible. DO NOT HANG UP, even if the caller does. If instructed, organize volunteers to search for suspicious looking packages, backpacks, or boxes. Include public areas and bathrooms in search process. Report findings to Incident Command. Be prepared to evacuate if/when directed to do so.
Missing Adult	Security Alert	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hospital personnel should search their immediate area and be on the lookout for the identified missing person. Report findings to Security.
Missing Infant/Child	Amber Alert	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All staff should be on the lookout for the identified infant or child. All exits should be covered. Stop and search all vehicles as well as people with bags, belongings, and carts.
Partial Facility Lockdown	Security Alert	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you are in the lockdown area, take direction from your supervisor. All others stay clear.
Full Facility Lockdown	Security Alert	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Respond as directed to instructions provided. Stay away from windows and doors.

Medical Alerts

Incident/Event	Code/Alert	Code/Alert Response Instructions
Pending Emergency/Disaster Situation	Code Triage Standby	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prepare for potential disaster situation and response. Review Code Triage Policy.
Emergency Department Needs Additional Assistance	Code Triage ED	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identified departments provide additional support and resources to the Emergency Department.
Emergency/Disaster Situation Full Activation Includes community or internal disasters	Code Triage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Follow instructions provided by Incident Command. Review Code Triage Policy.
Medical Emergency Adult or Pediatric	Code Blue	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Code Team responds to the immediate area with age-appropriate equipment. All others stay clear of the area.

Other

Incident/Event	Code/Alert	Code/Alert Response Instructions
Severe Weather	Weather Alert	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take necessary precautions that are appropriate to the situation.

Incident/Event	Code/Alert	Code/Alert Response Instructions
Massive Transfusion	Massive Transfusion Protocol	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hospital personnel who have been trained in Massive Transfusion protocol should report to the identified area.
Medical Response Team (MRT)	Medical Response Team	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hospital personnel who have been trained to respond to an MRT should report to the identified area.
