Surgery and Procedural Areas

Effective Friday, November 13, 2020

Surgical and Procedural areas are allowed one support person for the duration of the surgery or procedure.

- All support persons will be expected to wait in their designated waiting areas and maintain 6-foot distance requirements.
- All support persons must wear Munson Healthcare-issued masks for the duration of their visit.
- All support persons must wash hands or use alcohol sanitizer before and after leaving rooms as well as facility.
- Patients requiring in-house hospitalization post-surgery/procedure will be allowed to briefly see their support person after the recovery phase. The support person will not be allowed to accompany the patient to the inpatient unit.
- Patients who will be discharged post-surgery/procedure may have their support person present for discharge instructions.

Approved visitors:

- **Will be required to answer questions about their current health**
- **Will be required to provide their name and phone number for contact tracing purposes**

The following waiting rooms are available: Surgery and cath lab only. Cafeterias are not open to visitors at this time.
