

Bargaining Update March 16, 2019

Today, Munson Medical Center (MMC) and the Michigan Nurses Association (MNA) have reached a three-year tentative contract agreement.

As you know, we have been bargaining with the MNA since December of 2017. **We are very pleased to have reached this agreement, and feel strongly that the tentative agreement takes into account what is best for our entire Health Care Team across the system, our patients, and our communities, and affirms that this is a Great Place to Work.**

The MNA will schedule a ratification vote to allow MMC nurses to review and approve the tentative agreement. We hope that the nurses will accept this agreement, so we can continue to move forward as one Health Care Team.

This has been a long and challenging process, but we have remained committed to bargaining in good faith for a contract that is fair to MMC nurses and our entire Health Care Team.
