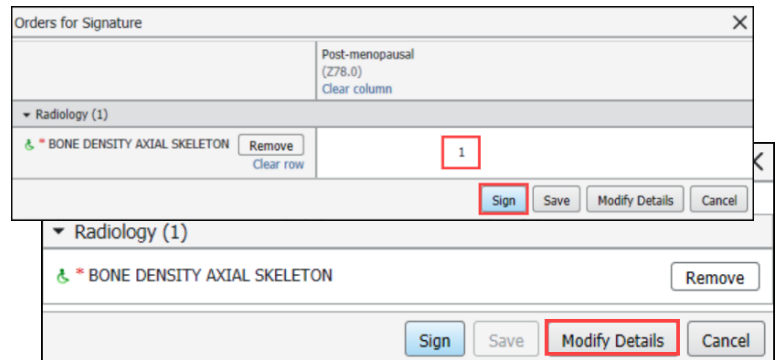
1. When a patient presents for an office visit, navigate to the **Recommendations** component on the Ambulatory Workflow page.
2. Check if patient is due for Bone Density Screening.
3. If the patient **is due** for Bone Density Screening, check if results are available in outside records.
4. If results **are present** in outside records, indicate that the test was done elsewhere.
 - a. Click on Bone Density Screening under Recommendations.
 - b. Click on **Actions**.
 - c. Select **Done Elsewhere**.
 - d. Change the **Satisfy Date** to the date that the test was performed.
 - e. Select a **Reason**.
 - f. Click **Save**.



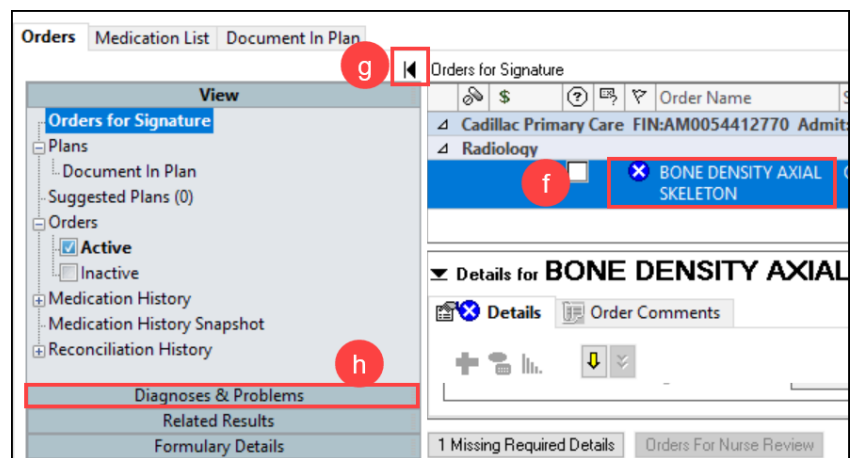
5. If **no results** are present:
 - a. Order Bone Density Axial Skeleton from **Recommendations** by clicking **Order: BONE DENSITY AXIAL SKELETON**.
 - b. On the Ordering Physician box: select **Order, Cosign Required** and click **OK**.
 - c. Click on **Orders for Signature**.



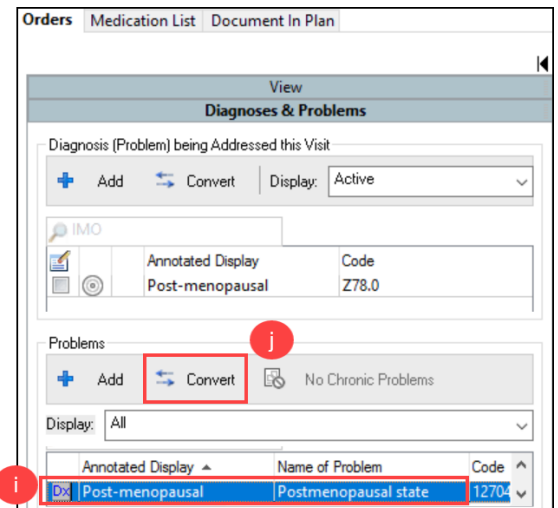
- d. If the provider **has** addressed problems for This Visit, associate the appropriate problem in Orders for Signature and click **Sign**.
- e. If the provider **has not** addressed problems for This Visit, click **Modify Details**.



- f. Highlight the order.
- g. Expand the navigator pane to the left of the Orders for Signature.
- h. Click on the **Diagnoses & Problems** band.

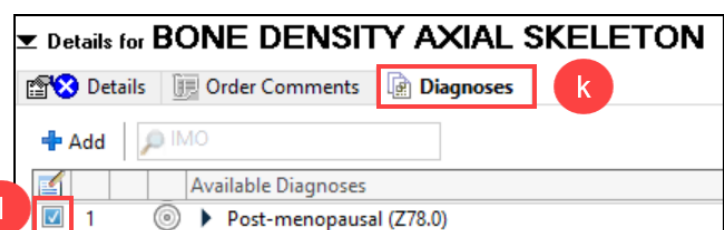


- i. Click the appropriate diagnosis from the Problems section on the left navigator.
 - i. Use the most specific Diagnosis. If unsure, ask the provider.
 - ii. The most commonly used diagnoses are:
 1. Post-menopausal Z78.0
 2. Age related bone loss M81.0
 - iii. If a common diagnosis is not present in the problem list, consult with the provider on what medically necessary diagnosis to use.

- j. Click **Convert** to convert it to a Diagnosis (Problem) being Addressed this Visit.

- k. The diagnosis is now available under the Diagnoses tab of the order Details.
- l. Check the box next to the diagnosis to associate the diagnosis to the order.
