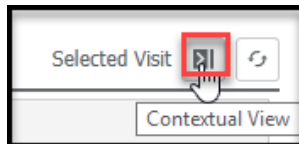



## Documentation: Manage-ED/Observation and Manage-UC MPages

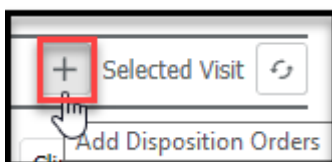
1. **On the Provider View, Manage-ED/Observation or Manage-UC MPage** review the patients' clinical information in the necessary components, while creating your documentation.
2. **Problem List Component:** To satisfy the requirements for the Problem List, enter at least one "This Visit Problem(s)" and at least one Chronic Problem or select No Chronic Problems.
3. Select **contextual view** for text components.



4. Populate any text components with free text, Dragon, Tag, Drag, or Auto Text/.Phrase.
5. The following components have standard auto text available:
  - A. Review of Systems: **.ed\_ros** auto text, use **F9** to move through drop down selections
  - B. Objective/Physical Exam: **.ed\_pe** auto text.
  - C. Procedure: **.ed\_procedure**.
6. **Complete ED or UC Discharge** (see *ED or UC Discharge instructions below*) & then select **ED or UC Provider Note** to populate and publish your note.

## Discharge: ED or UC Discharge MPage

1. **On the Provider View, ED or UC Discharge MPage** complete the required components indicated with a Red Asterisk: Problem List, Patient Education, Follow Up and Disposition Orders. Patient Education and Follow-up are not required for admitted patients.
2. **\*Problem List-** To satisfy the requirements for the Problem List, enter at least one "This Visit Problem(s)" and at least one Chronic Problem or select No Chronic Problems.
3. **\*Patient Education-** select from suggested item or  enter name of education you want to add in Search box.
4. **\*Follow up-**search for Provider and Location options, enter follow-up details. Click **Save**.
5. **\*Disposition Order-**Place DC order, Click +.

6. Create Note: **ED or UC Provider Note**. Sign/Submit. Sign.
7. Create Note: **ED or UC Discharge Instructions**. Sign/Submit. Sign & Print.
8. Reminder: Completed notes can be modified in the Documents component.
