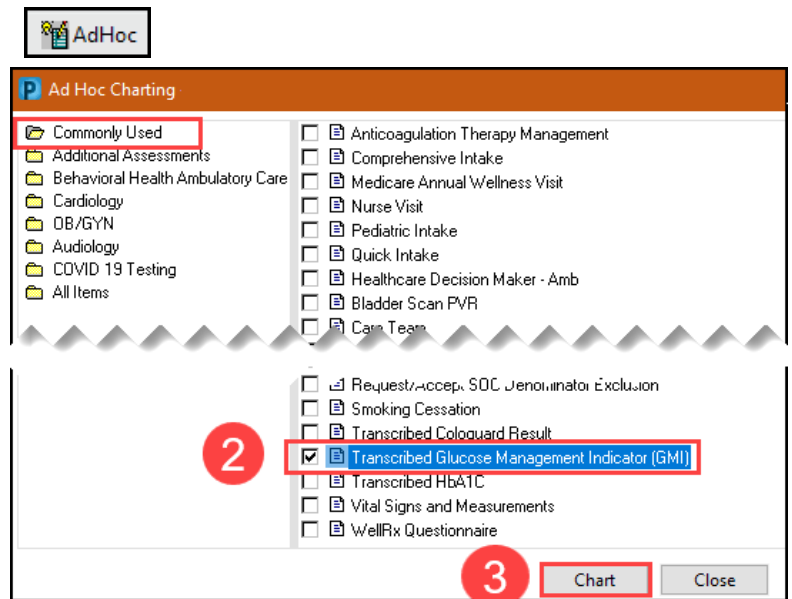

Transcribed Glucose Management Indicator (GMI) PowerForm is used to document a patient's Glucose Management Indicator (GMI) results. Documenting correctly on this PowerForm will meet payer requirements.

Glucose Management Indicator (GMI) Documentation

Opening the Transcribed Glucose Management Indicator (GMI) PowerForm:

1. Navigate to **AdHoc** on the PowerChart toolbar.
2. Locate and select the **Transcribed Glucose Management Indicator (GMI)** PowerForm from the Commonly Used folder.
3. Click **Chart**.



Transcribed Glucose Management Indicator (GMI) PowerForm documentation:

4. Update the **Performed on** date to match the **End Date** for the GMI.
5. Enter the **Start Date** and **End Date**.
 - **Note: Both dates must be entered.**
6. Document the GMI results.
7. Click the green check mark to sign and save the documentation.
