


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MAR Overview

The MAR (Medication Administration Record) displays medication orders and administration tasks entered by providers, nurses, or pharmacy staff.


The MAR sections:

- Navigator with Time and Therapeutic Class Views to see different medication categories.
- Medication Section that displays medications and associated order details.
- Administration Columns that contain dates and times the medication is given. The current date and time column is highlighted in yellow.
- Time Frame Bar.



MAR Functions


- 1. The Navigator allows viewing medications from:
 - a) The Time View displays
 - Scheduled.
 - Unscheduled.
 - PRN.
 - Continuous Infusions.
 - Discontinued medication sections for any medication once completed.






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b) The Therapeutic Class View displays medication grouped by drug-classes.




2. Hover over the name of the medication to view the details of the order.

- Right click on the name of the medication to:
 - View Order Info.
 - Access Reference Manual information about the drug.
 - Send a Med Request to the pharmacy.
 - Create/View Admin Note regarding the medication.



Remember:

The MAR is used when gathering and preparing medications. The MAR shows when the medication was given or if it was not given yet. Medication corrections must be done on the MAR.
