

MAR Summary Overview for Nurses

Overview of Sections

The MAR Summary displays medication orders and administration tasks. Medication orders are entered by providers, nurses, or pharmacy staff.

- Nurses must check the MAR/MAR Summary at the start of each shift.
- The MAR/MAR Summary are used to prepare/collect medications prior to administration.
- Medication administration is done using the Medication Administration Wizard (MAW) button.

MAR Summary sections:

1. Navigator.
2. Medication Section.
3. Administration Columns.
4. Time Frame Bar.

Navigator

The Navigator button has two pages (views):

1. Time View.
2. Therapeutic Class View.

1. The Time View displays medications by groups.
 - a) Click on desired group to view medications in that specific group.

2. The Therapeutic Class View organizes medications by drug classes.
 - a) Right click on the medication to view:
 - Order Info.
 - Reference Manual.

The Reference Manual has multiple tabs:

What is the most important information I should know about metoprolol?

- You should not use this medicine if you have a serious heart problem (heart block, sick sinus syndrome, slow heart rate), severe circulation problems, severe heart failure, or a history of slow heart beats that caused fainting.

What is metoprolol?

- Metoprolol is a beta-blocker that affects the heart and circulation (blood flow through arteries and veins).
- Metoprolol is used to treat angina (chest pain) and hypertension (high blood pressure). It is also used to tell your doctor if you are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. It is not known whether metoprolol will harm an unborn baby. However, having high blood pressure during pregnancy may cause complications such as diabetes or eclampsia (dangerously high blood pressure that can lead to medical problems in both mother

Details

The Administration Columns contain the status of the medication:

- After a one-time medication is administered, the medication area displays in grey.
- Hover over the data in the Administration Columns to view the details of medication administration.

Time Frame

The Time Frame Bar defaults to display Column Time Intervals every 24 hours and shows four days: one in the future, today (highlighted in yellow), and two days in the past.
