

## **MUNSON REGIONAL EMS EDUCATION**

### **BASIC EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN COURSE**

**WHAT:** This Michigan Department of Health and Human Services approved course, taught by professionals in the emergency care field, will provide fundamental working knowledge for an entry level position as an EMT-basic. Topics covered include medical-legal issues, basic anatomy, patient assessment, basic life support, vehicle extrication, and pre-hospital care of medical and trauma emergencies. A minimum of 48 hours of clinical/observation time is required in addition to the scheduled class time. During clinical experiences students may be exposed to hazardous materials, communicable diseases, lifting and moving of patients, and more. Saturday sessions are required as determined by the instructor in the course schedule. Persons successfully completing this course will be eligible for the National Registry of EMT examination. Total course hours = 305 (257 classroom/48 clinical). This course exceeds requirements set forth by MDHHS. This course is taught according to current National EMS Education standards. **This class will be a blended course. The online components of this class are required.**

**Prerequisites:** MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE THE FIRST NIGHT OF CLASS

- 1) Proof of Hepatitis B vaccination (or in the process of receiving the vaccination), or signed declination form.
- 2) Proof of MMR (measles, mumps, rubella) vaccination.
- 3) Proof of Varicella vaccination or have had the chicken pox.
- 4) Proof of Tetanus (less than 10 years).
- 5) TB skin test or chest x-ray within the past 12 months.
- 6) Proof of current influenza vaccination.
- 7) Professional liability insurance (obtained by student affiliated agency or commercial insurance company ~ \$40.00).
- 8) High School diploma or GED (must be 18 years old to obtain Michigan licensure).
- 9) Obtain and submit a criminal background check: <https://apps.michigan.gov/> (~ \$10)

**Location:** Foster Family Community Health Center, EMS Education classroom, 550 Munson Ave, Traverse City, Michigan, 49686.

**When:** Class will be 2 days per week, approximately 4 hours per session. Specific days and times to be determined by course instructor. There will also be occasional Saturday sessions as determined by the course instructor and stated in the posted course schedule.

**Cost:** \$1750.00 per student. Cost includes textbooks and uniforms. MREMSE reserves the right to cancel the course if enrollment is less than 10.

**Instructors:** MREMSE staff and subject matter experts as approved by the Program Director.

**Registration:** Online at [munsonhealthcare.org/clinical-education/ems-education](http://munsonhealthcare.org/clinical-education/ems-education). Registration must be received no later than at least 10 business days prior to the first day of the class. Admission is on a first come, first serve basis. MREMSE reserves the right to alter course offerings based on need/demand. Maximum enrollment for this course is 18 students.

**Payment:** \$250 non-refundable deposit MUST accompany on-line registration. Payment in full is due first night of class unless prior arrangements are made with the Program Director. Agency billing arrangements must be made with the Program Director. Munson Regional EMS Education does not provide direct financial assistance. However, Munson Regional EMS Education can assist with financial assistance resources.
