

Michigan EMT Additional Skills and Psychomotor Testing

New to the state of Michigan? Considering relocating to Michigan? Munson Regional EMS Education can help with obtaining an EMT license in Michigan.

Michigan requires EMTs to be proficient in the skills of supraglottic airways, CPAP use, Epi-Pen, Albuterol, and Narcan Administration. These are not included in minimal standards and training set by National Registry of EMTs. Munson Regional EMS Education is a CoAEMSP and state approved Education program that can provide this required training.

Munson Regional EMS Education can also provide NREMT skill testing for EMT licensing upon successful completion of the NREMT cognitive exam. For information regarding additional skills required by Michigan, NREMT psychomotor skills for EMT, or initial education contact Robert Rudzki, Program Director.
