

New Soap and Water Bath for Patients with Allergy to CHG for Providers and Nurses

Summary: All patients that have Central Venous and Hemodialysis Catheters should have a daily Chlorhexidine (CHG) bath. Soap and water or prepackaged bath wipes may be substituted if the patient has an allergy to CHG.



Soap and Water Bath - Chin to Toe Task

To order the Soap and Water Bath – Chin to Toe Task within Central Venous Catheters related PowerPlans:

- a. Within the Patient Care section, locate a phase with preselected Chlorhexidine Bath-Chin to Toe Task.
- b. If a patient has an allergy to CHG, deselect the box to the left from this task.
- c. Select the **NEW** available Soap and Water Bath-Chin to Toe Task.
- d. Click Orders for Signature and continue signing the order until completed.



If the steps of ordering Soap and Water Bath – Chin to Toe Task is skipped for a patient with a recorded allergy to CHG, an allergy alert appears:

- a. CANCEL Chlorhexidine Bath Chin to Toe Task is already preselected.
- b. Click OK to order Soap and Water Bath Chin to Toe Task.



If a user decides to continue ordering Chlorhexidine Bath – Chin to Toe Task for a patient with an allergy to CHG:

- a. Select ORDER Chlorhexidine Bath Chin to Toe Task.
- b. Deselect the box to the left of Soap and Water Bath Chin to Toe Task.
- c. Click OK.

- d. Select the appropriate explanation in Provide the Reason for Override.
- e. If needed, add any details in Additional freetext reason area.
- f. Click OK.
