

PFT Patient Pre-Test Instructions

Patient Preparation

- 1. Refrain from smoking for at least 6 hours before test.
- 2. Refrain from having a heavy meal or alcohol at least 2 hours before testing.
- 3. Do not wear restrictive clothing that could restrict breathing.
- 4. Do not take medications that affect lung function see list below:

Stop these inhaled medicines for at least 24 hours before your appointment

- Advair[®] (Serevent[®] and Flovent[®])
- Serevent® (Salmeterol)
- Serevent® (Salmeterol)
 Symbicort® (Pulmicort® and Foradil®)
 Perforomist® (Formote Brovana (Arfomoterol))
- Dulera® (Azmanex® and Foradil®)
- Foradil® (Formoterol)
 - Perforomist® (Formoterol)

 - Spiriva® (tiotropium)

Stop these inhaled medicines for at least 6 hours before your appointment:

- Atrovent[®] (Ipatroprium)
- Combivent® (Albuterol and Ipatropium)
- DuoNeb® (Albuterol and Ipatropium)

Stop these inhaled medicines for at least 4-6 hours before your appointment:

- Proventil HFA®
- Ventolin HFA®
- Maxair[®] (Pirbuterol)
- ProAir® (any form of Albuterol or albuterol sulfate)
- Alupent[®]
- Metaprel® (Metaproterenol)
- Xopenex® (Levalbuterol)
