

#### **Documenting Opioid Risk from Scales and Assessments:**

- 1. Select Opioid Risk Tool from the Scales and Assessments component on the Ambulatory Workflow page.

- 3. Notify the provider of a score equal to or greater than 3.




- 2. Complete the Opioid Risk Tool.
- 3. Notify the provider of a score equal to or greater than 3.

#### **Providers**

- Clinical Staff will notify providers of an Opioid Risk score equal to or greater than 3.
  - A score of 2 or lower indicates low risk for future opioid use disorder; a score of greater than or equal to
     3 indicates high risk for opioid use disorder.
- The Opioid Risk Tool Score and Interpretation will display on the Scales and Assessments component of the Ambulatory Workflow pages.



- The Opioid Risk Score completed on the day of the visit will flow into select notes under Objective, Screening Tool Scores.
