Call the physician to initiate planned PowerPlans to activate orders needed to care for your patient. A PowerPlan in an Initiated state has activated orders and may be acted upon by staff caring for the patient.

Customize View

Clicking Customize View brings up a Customize View window that allows the user to make customizations to the Orders Flowsheet.

- 1. Select the category that you would like to see on the Orders Flowsheet as a column.
- 2. Click on Add.
- The selected category will show in *Selected columns. *Selected columns are all the columns that will show in the Orders Flowsheet.
- Choose the up or down arrow to order the columns. Repeat 1-4 for each additional column that you would like to add.
- 5. Select OK once you are satisfied with the columns that are selected.
