

Pharmacy to Review Route of Administration for Gastric Tubes for MMC Nurses only

Summary: Pharmacy will review medications for route of administration accuracy when:

- A new nasogastric (NG) tube insertion or oral gastric (OG) tube insertion order is placed or discontinued.
- A patient has a Percutaneous Endoscopic Gastrostomy (PEG) tube present on admission, placed or removed during the hospital encounter.

NG and OG Tube Pharmacy Consult Orders

- Provider enters orders to insert or discontinue NG or OG tube.
- A pharmacy consult order will automatically generate to Review Meds for Route of Administration.

PEG Tube Pharmacy Consult Orders

PEG Present on Admission or Inserted During Encounter

- 1. In IView, create a dynamic group for the PEG tube.
- 2. Select Assessment.
- 3. Select:
 - Inserted if placed during this encounter, OR
 - Present on admission (new option).
- A pharmacy consult order will automatically generate to Review Meds for Route of Administration.



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Note: No further documentation on this dynamic group will generate a new Pharmacy Consult, with the exception of checking **Removed**.

PEG Removed

- Select Removed when provider enters the order for PEG removal.
- 2. A new pharmacy consult order to Review Meds for Route of Administration will automatically generate.
