1	Patients 3 years or older with the symptom of a sore throat, go to the Clinical Staff Orders.	ICD-10 J02.9	Description Acute sore throat
2	Select Rapid Strep POC From POC Testing. Choose the Order type Cosign required . Click Orders for Signature.		
3	If the provider has added This Visit problems, associate the correct problem/diagnosis.		
4	If no problems/diagnoses have been added to This Visit, click Modify Details, add then associate the diagnosis J02.9 Acute sore throat to the order.		
5	Click Sign .		
6	Administer the Strep test.		
7	Document Strep Screen POC Task from the Task List.		
8	Document the POC Strep Screen PowerForm details. Update the Performed on Date and Time to the time of the specimen collection. Sign the form.		
9	If the Strep screen result was positive , the provider is to treat Streptococcal infection. Add the appropriate strep diagnosis to the problem list.		
10	If the Strep screen result was negative , ordering a Group A Strep PCR is recommended.
