

CME Requirements for Advanced Practice Providers

APRN Licensing Requirements:

- Michigan License: minimum of 25 hours every two years
 - A minimum of 2 hours must be in the area of pain and symptom management.

- **AANP:** 100 hours within five-year certification cycle
 - o 25 credits must be in the area of advanced practice pharmacology.
 - Precepting* is an optional criterion that can be used to replace up to 25 nonpharmacology CE credits.

*Precepting is defined as serving as a clinical preceptor for interdisciplinary advanced health care student(s) while providing direct patient care as a nurse practitioner in your area of certification.

- **AMBC:** 20 hours within five-year certification cycle

- NBCRNA: four-year cycle
 - o 60 Class A credits
 - o 40 Class B credits

PA Licensing Requirements:

- Michigan License: No CE required for licensure
- NCCPA: 100 hours every two years with at least 50 hours in Category 1* CME credit

*Category 1 CME includes: AMA PRA Category 1 credit, AOA Category 1-A credit, AAFP Prescribed Credit, AAPA Category 1 CME credit

All **APRNs** and **PAs** have a **one-time** requirement of training in identifying victims of **human trafficking**.

An APRN or physician assistant seeking a controlled substance license, or who is licensed to prescribe or dispense controlled substances, must complete a **one-time** training in **opioids and controlled substance awareness** prior to being issued a controlled substance license.

NEW Beginning on June 1, 2022, and for every renewal thereafter, an applicant for license or registration renewal must have completed a minimum of 1 hour of implicit bias training for each year of the applicant's license or registration cycle.
