Preventing Infection: Protecting Patients and Our Health Care Team

Effective Monday, March 16, 2020

In accordance with Governor Whitmer's directive for the state of Michigan, all visitors are prohibited from entering this facility, with the following exceptions:

- Two visitors may accompany a pediatric patient.
- Visitors, including children who are 21 years of age or under, who are visiting patients that are at the end of life.
- One visitor may accompany a surgical patient. If the surgical patient is admitted to the hospital post-surgery, the visitor must leave the hospital at that point.
- Visitors necessary for the provision of medical care for a patient (i.e. visitors who need to understand medical instructions for patients).
- Visitors who support of activities of daily living for a patient.
- Visitors who must exercise of power of attorney or court-appointed guardianship for a patient.
- Parents, foster parents or guardians of patients who are 21 years of age or under.
- Visitors to a patient who is in serious or critical condition or in hospice care.
- Those who are visiting under exigent/urgent circumstances.
- Visitors performing official governmental functions.

Visitors who enter any Munson Healthcare facility will be screened.

Please be prepared to answer questions about your current health, travel history, and contact with people exhibiting signs of COVID-19.

Every individual must wash hands or use alcohol sanitizer before and after leaving any rooms as well as the Munson Healthcare facility.
