Within PowerChart, navigate to Inventory Management

- 1. Click the drop-down under View and select Immunization Management.
- 2. Click the drop-down under Location and select the appropriate location.
- 3. Click the Display drop-down and select Immunizations.

Quick Tips for Reconciliation

- If both the inventory and immunization count are zero, remove the immunization from the inventory manager.
- If the inventory has a negative (-) amount, determine if the count is accurate or if an error occurred. A waste or transfer of immunizations may have to occur to get a zero count to remain. Then remove it from the inventory.
- If the inventory is expired, document waste until the count is zero. Then remove from the inventory manager.
- If an immunization is counted, but not listed on the inventory report, add the immunization to the inventory and document any doses given.
